



## Official Rules - Competition

### Organizers

The competition is held by the Foundation “Grâce à lui” (the “Organizers”).

### Duration of the competition

This competition runs from 9 :00 a.m., on **April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2025**, until December 31, **2025**, at 11:59 pm (EH) (the “Competition Period”).

### Eligibility

This competition is open to any natural individual residing either in Canada or outside Canada, 18 years old and over at the time of the entry (the « Eligible participants »). An individual is eligible to all competition carried out through the Foundation.

### How to enter

No purchase or consideration required. To participate in the competition without purchase or consideration, eligible participants must follow the instructions written in the memo attached to these rules. This memo could be modified according to the dynamic situations chosen during this period of the year.

### Limits and exclusions to all entries

Limits: limit of one (1) entry per eligible participant.

Exclusions: Employees, agents, directors, and representatives of the Foundation as well as all persons of whom they are domiciled are excluded from the competition.

### Procedure for identifying the winner.

To be declared a winner, the following rules must be respected:

- a) The winner will be contacted *by Instagram* by the organizers to be informed of the terms and conditions for delivering the prize during the following ten (10) days after the competition. The selected participant must respond to it (she/he will have three (3) days after having received the message) in accordance with the instructions given, if applicable, failing which she/he would lose his/her right to the prize.
- b) The winner will complete and sign the declaration and liability waiver form (**the declaration form**), which will be sent to the selected participant by email by the organizers of the competition to confirm compliance with all the conditions provided in these official rules and return it duly completed and signed to the organizers of the competition, by email, in digitized form that they will receive within five (5) days of its receipt by the participant.
- c) Provided that all conditions mentioned in these rules have been met, the organizers will contact the winner within five (5) days after the receipt of the declaration form by the organizers, to award the prize.
- d) Failure to comply one of the conditions mentioned in these rules or to accept his prize, the selected participant will be disqualified. In such event, the organizers may, at its sole discretion, cancel the prize or conduct a new competition until an entry is selected and declared as winner for that prize.

## General conditions

- 1) **Verifications:** the documents allowing participation in the competition and the declaration and liability waiver forms are submitted to verifications by the organizers. Any document which is or may be incomplete, inaccurate, illegible, mutilated, mechanically reproduced, deteriorated, fraudulent, filed or transmitted late, containing an invalid email address, will be rejected, and will not be awarded.
- 2) **Disqualification:** any person participating in this competition or attempting to participate by a means contrary to these rules and likely to be unfair to the other participants (example: hacking, using of a nominee) will be automatically disqualified and could be recommended to the competent judicial authorities. The decision of the organizers to this effect is final and without appeal.
- 3) **Progress to the Competition:** any attempt aiming to sabotage the legitimate progress of this contest constitutes a violation of civil and criminals' law. If such attempts are made, the organizers reserve the right to reject the participant's entries and to obtain redress under the law.
- 4) **Acceptance of the prize:** the prize must be accepted as described in these rules and will not, in any case, in whole or in part, be exchanged, substituted, or transferred to another person. It will not also be replaced by other prize, subject to what is otherwise provided for in these regulations.
- 5) **Limit of responsibilities (use of the prize):** the winner releases the organizers and the persons responsible for this competition from any liability for damages that may result from his participation in this competition, acceptance, and use of the prize.
- 6) **Limit of responsibilities (progress of the competition) :** the organizers and the persons responsible for this competition are released from any responsibility relating *to malfunction of any computer component, any software or any communication line*, in connection with a loss or absence to network communication or for any failing transmission, incomplete, incomprehensible or deleted by any computer or network and which may limit the possibility for a person to read the rules, participate to this competition or prevent it.
- 7) **Limit of responsibilities (receipt of participations):** the organizers and the persons responsible for this competition will not be responsible for *any lost, misdirected, or late entries*, whether or not attributable to any failure, for whatever reason of the website or any component of the system and network of telecommunications during the duration of this contest, including any damage that may be caused, directly or indirectly, in whole or in part, to a participant's computer or mobile device.
- 8) **Limit of responsibilities (situation out of control):** the organizers and the persons responsible for this competition will not assume any responsibility of any kind whatsoever in any cases where their inability to act results from an act or a *situation beyond* their control or from a strike, a lock-out or any other labor dispute in the establishments of the organizations or companies whose services are used for the holding of this competition.
- 9) **Modification of the competition:** the organizer of the competition reserves the right, at its sole discretion, *to cancel*, terminate, modify, or suspend, in whole or in part, this competition in the eventuality to which there is an event or *any human intervention* that may alter or influence the administration, security, fairness, integrity, impartiality or the progress of this competition. No responsibility can be attributed to it.
- 10) **Authorization:** the winner of this prize authorizes the organizers and the persons responsible for this competition to use, if required, his names, photograph, images, voice, place of residence and the

declaration related to the price for advertising purposes, without any form of remuneration. The winner sends a video to the Foundation in which she/he confirms that she/he has received the prize.

- 11) **Communication with participants:** no communication or correspondence will be exchanged to participants as part of this competition other than in accordance with these rules.
- 12) **Personal information:** personal information collected on entrants will be only used for purpose of administering this competition. Any commercial or other communication unrelated to this competition will not be sent to participants, at least they permit it.
- 13) **Property:** the declaration forms are the property of the organizers of this competition and will not be returned to participants under any circumstances.
- 14) **Identification of the winner:** the name of the winner will be announced on Instagram.
- 15) **Decision of the organizers of this competition:** any decision of the organizers or the persons responsible of this competition relating to this competition is final and without appeal.
- 16) **Divisibility of paragraphs:** if any paragraph of these rules is declared or founded to be illegal, unenforceable, or void by a competent court; then, that paragraph will be considered void, but all other paragraphs that are not affected will be applied to the extend permitted by law.
- 17) **Language:** A French and Spanish version of these rules is also available on the Foundation's website. In the event of a discrepancy among the French, Spanish and English version of these rules, the French version shall prevail.

**Competition or activities**

A few competitions or activities will be carried out during 2025. The terms and conditions of the competitions will be announced in live or before the realization of each of them. Once the terms and conditions are established, the participants must follow them to get the prize.

**Prize**

The prize offered in those competition or activities is expressed in Canadian dollars or in the equivalent value of the conversion according to the country in which the winner is situated. The amount of the prize will be paid to the winner by Bank deposit, Interac (in Canada), Paypal or Wester-Union. The prize is non-transferable and non-negotiable.

**Opportunities to win.**

Odds of winning depend on the number of eligible entries received during the period of the competition or activities. The awarding of the prize is limited to one prize per person. The Foundation reserves the right to disqualify a person or cancel an entry that does not comply with the rule of each competition or activities.

The organizers reserve the right to refuse those participants who use a vulgar, obscene, slanderous, defamatory, or malicious language during the competition or activities.
